SUBJECT: RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING AND EXTENDING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS UNDER AB 361 FOR CONTINUED VIRTUAL MEETINGS

BACKGROUND

The Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code § 54950 et seq.) generally requires local agencies meeting via teleconference, including through other virtual or electronic means, to provide public access at each location in which members of the legislative body are teleconferencing. The Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 361 (AB 361), which amended Government Code section 54953 to allow local agencies to meet fully virtually during a proclaimed state of emergency if state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing. Governor Newsom has issued a proclamation declaring a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to section 8625 of the California Emergency Services Act.

Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority adopted Resolution No. 2021-04 on December 16, 2021 finding that the requisite conditions continue to exist for the legislative body of the Water Employee Services Authority to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953. Subsequently, the determination intentions to continue to promote social distancing has been reconsidered and extended no less than every thirty days since the initial determination. On June 23, 2022 the Board made the determination to extend the virtual protocol, adopting a resolution extending the findings and determinations for continued virtual meetings through July 23, 2022. Staff recommends adoption of the attached resolution at this time, further extending the use of virtual meetings through August 27, 2022.

The General Manager and staff recommend that the Board of Directors:

1. Adopt a Resolution Reaffirming and Extending Findings and Determinations Under AB 361 For Continued Virtual Meetings.

RESOLUTION 2022-09

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY REAFFIRMING AND EXTENDING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS UNDER AB 361 FOR CONTINUED VIRTUAL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code § 54950 *et seq.*) generally requires local agencies meeting via teleconference, including through other virtual or electronic means, to provide public access at each location in which members of the legislative body are teleconferencing; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recently enacted Assembly Bill 361 (AB 361), which amended Government Code section 54953 to allow local agencies to meet fully virtually during a proclaimed state of emergency if state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that the Governor issued a proclamation declaring a state of emergency on March 4, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to section 8625 of the California Emergency Services Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority adopted Resolution No. 2021-04 on December 16, 2021 finding that the requisite conditions continue to exist for the legislative body of the Water Employee Services Authority to conduct remote teleconference meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953, and has again reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency and finds that state or local officials continue to recommend measures to promote social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has subsequently extended and reaffirmed the desires to continue to hold virtual meetings as directed by the Board pursuant to AB 361 and Government Code section 54953(e) since adopting Resolution No 2021-04 and desires to extend the provisions once again.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority as follows:

- 1. The above recitals and true and correct and shall be the findings of the Water Employee Services Authority Board of Directors.
- 2. The Board of Directors shall be authorized to continue to meet virtually in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and without compliance with section 54953(b)(3).
- 3. This Resolution does not prevent or prohibit the Water Employee Services Authority from holding hybrid meetings (containing both virtual and in-person components) or from meeting in-person, provided such meetings comply with

AB 361 and with all state and local health orders. The Water Employee Services Authority shall comply with all rules established by the Board of Directors and/or the General Manger for attendance at meetings.

4. The Board of Directors shall take action to renew this Resolution every thirty days for as long as any state or local officials continue to recommend any measures to promote social distancing, but the Board of Directors may terminate the Resolution at any time. In the event that more than 30 days pass between regular Board meetings, the Board of Directors shall take action to renew this Resolution prior to taking any action or engaging in any deliberation or discussion in a virtual meeting; renewal of this Resolution may occur either at the beginning of the next regular meeting or at a special meeting called for such purposes. In the event this Resolution has lapsed, and the Board of Directors has not terminated it, any commission, committee or other Brown Act board of the Water Employee Services Authority shall be authorized to, and shall, make any required findings in order to meet virtually under AB 361.

SUBJECT: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT NO. 1 BETWEEN THE WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY AND THE WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY EMPLOYEE'S ASSOCIATION

BACKGROUND

In February 2022, the Water Employee Services Authority (WESA) and the WESA Employee's Association (EA) ratified the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), effective January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024. After implementation of the terms specified in the MOU, EA members have requested an additional consideration for Section 23, as it relates specifically to overtime premiums. Currently, EA employees are permitted to convert overtime hours earned to compensatory time off (CTO), up to a maximum of 80 hours. The EA has requested that standby overtime hours worked be included in this provision.

Side Letter No. 1 to the WESA EA MOU is being presented for consideration of approval of the following:

"This side letter is to the referenced Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2024, and amends Article V, Section 23, subd. D., *in italics*, as follows:

Section 23. Overtime Premiums

D.) Employees shall have the right to receive compensatory time off (CTO) in lieu of overtime pay, *including overtime accrued working standby*, on a dollar-for-dollar basis, at the employee's discretion. The employee must notify Human Resources of this request in writing by the last Friday of the pay period in which the overtime/standby overtime is earned."

This change will allow EA employees to convert earned standby overtime hours to CTO, in addition to earned overtime hours, with no changes to maximum accruals or any other accrual provisions. Adding this benefit for EA employees will result in little to no additional costs for the District. The administration of this additional process will be minimal and therefore not anticipated to have any measurable cost impact.

The General Manager and staff recommend that the Board of Directors:

SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY AND THE WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY EMPLOYEE'S ASSOCIATION

This Side Letter Agreement to the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between Water Employee Services Authority ("WESA") and The Water Employee Services Authority Employee's Association ("EA"), effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2024, amends Article V, Section 23, subd, D., *in italics*, as follows:

Section 23. Overtime Premiums

D.) Employees shall have the right to receive compensatory time off (CTO) in lieu of overtime pay, *including overtime pay accrued working standby*, on a dollar-for-dollar basis, at the employee's discretion. The employee must notify Human Resources of this request in writing by the last Friday of the pay period in which the overtime is earned.

This side letter agreement is executed as an integral part of the MOU. Except as herein modified, the aforesaid MOU shall remain in full force and effect during the remainder of its term.
