**MEETINGS** 

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code § 54950 *et seq.*) generally requires local agencies meeting via teleconference, including through other virtual or electronic means, to provide public access at each location in which members of the legislative body are teleconferencing. The Legislature recently enacted Assembly Bill 361 (AB 361), which amended Government Code section 54953 to allow local agencies to meet fully virtually during a proclaimed state of emergency if state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing. Governor Newsom has issued a proclamation declaring a state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to section 8625 of the California Emergency Services Act.

Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority (WESA) has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency and in light of state or local officials' continued recommendations to promote social distancing, desires to continue the option to have its Board Meetings held virtually, pursuant to AB 361 and Government Code section 54953(e). The attached resolution being presented for the Board's consideration declares findings and determinations under AB 361 for continued virtual meetings. If necessary, the Board can renew the resolution every 30 days.

The General Manager and staff recommend that the Board of Directors:

 Adopt a Resolution Making Findings and Determinations Under AB 361 for Continued Virtual Meetings

#### RESOLUTION 2021-02

#### RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE WATER EMPLOYEE SERVICES AUTHORITY MAKING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS UNDER AB 361 FOR CONTINUED VIRTUAL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code § 54950 *et seq.*) generally requires local agencies meeting via teleconference, including through other virtual or electronic means, to provide public access at each location in which members of the legislative body are teleconferencing; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recently enacted Assembly Bill 361 (AB 361), which amended Government Code section 54953 to allow local agencies to meet fully virtually during a proclaimed state of emergency if state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors finds that the Governor issued a proclamation declaring a state of emergency on March 4, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to section 8625 of the California Emergency Services Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency and finds that state or local officials continue to recommend measures to promote social distancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors desires to continue to hold virtual meetings pursuant to AB 361 and Government Code section 54953(e).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Water Employee Services Authority as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and shall be the findings of the Water Employee Services Authority Board of Directors.
- 2. The Board of Directors shall be authorized to continue to meet virtually in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and without compliance with section 54953(b)(3).
- 3. This Resolution does not prevent or prohibit the Water Employee Services Authority from holding hybrid meetings (containing both virtual and in-person components) or from meeting in-person, provided such meetings comply with AB 361 and with all state and local health orders. The Water Employee Services Authority shall comply with all rules established by the Board of Directors and/or the General Manger for attendance at meetings.
- 4. The Board of Directors shall take action to renew this Resolution every thirty days for as long as any state or local officials continue to recommend any

measures to promote social distancing, but the Board of Directors may terminate the Resolution at any time. In the event that more than 30 days pass between regular Board meetings, the Board of Directors shall take action to renew this Resolution prior to taking any action or engaging in any deliberation or discussion in a virtual meeting; renewal of this Resolution may occur either at the beginning of the next regular meeting or at a special meeting called for such purposes. In the event this Resolution has lapsed, and the Board of Directors has not terminated it, any commission, committee or other Brown Act board of the Water Employee Services Authority shall be authorized to, and shall, make any required findings in order to meet virtually under AB 361.
